

# Sport Premium

## ***What is Sport Premium?***

Sport Premium is an amount of money which the government has agreed to allocate to schools. The funding amount schools receive is based upon the number of children of primary age the school has at Jan. of that year. The sport premium is to be used to increase the quality & breadth of PE & Sport provision, and increasing participation in PE & Sport.

At **Easington Colliery Primary School**, we strive to promote healthy and active lifestyles and aim to provide sporting opportunities for all our pupils.

The 2015-2016 Sport Premium funding for **Easington Colliery Primary School** was **£9,945.00.**

The money was used for:

### **1) Investing in the Easington School Sport Partnership Service Level Agreement to provide the school with the following:**

- Liaise with the school to develop an annual bespoke P.E. & Sport action plan.
- Providing curriculum support and high quality CPD for teachers, teaching assistants, NQT's, team teaching, twilights, professional development days etc.
- Provision of High Quality Coaching support across a variety of sports.
- A full organised annual programme of competitions/tournaments/festivals **in addition** to the National School Games.
- Participation, inclusion and excellence opportunities.
- Identifying the gifted & talented children in P.E & Sport
- Provision of an after-school activity in every term in a variety of sports.
- SSP Network meetings to support PE Co-ordinators / PLTs in their role developing PE & sport within their school.
- Identifying opportunities for young leaders to practise their skills through volunteering in schools.
- Assistance in the process of applying for national 'Kitemark' status for High Quality Provision of P.E. & School Sport.
- Promotion and development of links to local sports club.
- Sustain and grow the network of Change4life clubs.
- Central co-ordination of school sport programmes in SSP area.

### **2) Other ways that Easington Colliery Primary School has utilised the School Sport Premium**

- Invest in a swimming programme to ensure children are given the opportunity to achieve their 25 metre certificate before they leave Key Stage 2.
- Purchase school P.E. clothing so that children are inspired to engage in P.E. lessons and also school sport competitions.
- Replenish equipment to support with the delivery of High Quality P.E. and School Sport.
- Booking transport to ensure children can access ALL events and competitions.

### **3) Impact: The Sport Premium Funding has impacted our school in the following ways:**

- Successful up-skilling and training for our staff, raising the standards in school sport and PE through external support from coaches and qualified specialists.
- Increasing the levels of participation through events organised in addition to weekly P.E. (Sport Relief, Event/Competition trials/training sessions).

- Engaging the less active children in a wider range of activities to improve fitness levels by offering a broader exposure to a range of sports.
- New equipment has allowed staff to deliver higher quality sessions.
- School P.E. kit/Team kit has identified the high priority Easington Colliery Primary School holds for P.E. and physical development, raising participation and increasing levels of understanding for personal health and well-being.

#### **4) Sustainability – How will we make sure these are sustainable?**

- Continue to access CPD offered by NGB, SSP, CSP and other organisations to ensure staff are receiving up to date knowledge and adaptable skills.
- Continue to offer sporting experiences in addition to weekly P.E. lessons. The school is committed to opening up event/competition teams to everyone eligible to ensure a consistent approach to selection.
- Ensure our After-School Activities are varied and aimed at a range of age and ability groups.
- Continue to manage equipment ensuring it is used effectively and replenish when stock levels become low.
- Utilise clothing to ensure children feel valued as a team and to increase understanding of what is appropriate attire.
