School lunches must be paid for in advance. The cost of school lunches is £1.85 a day (£9.25 per week). If you are struggling to access ParentPay please call the school office.



- Please remember that if your child has any of the symptoms (high temperature, loss of taste/smell and new and continuous cough) they **MUST NOT** come to school. You will need to contact 119 to arrange for a test and your child cannot return to school unless the test is negative.
- If anyone in your household has any of these symptoms, then they **MUST NOT** come to school. The person who has the symptoms must also get a test and the whole household has to self-isolate until a negative result has been given.
- Your child **MUST NOT** come to school if they live in a household where anyone has a positive COVID-19 test or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 and have been advised to self-isolate by Track and Trace.
