Starting next week, any children that are eligible to receive benefit-related free school meals will receive a weekly supermarket voucher via the Government scheme. This will be from the same provider as in the summer and will be emailed to the parent. Please note that you will not receive a voucher if you child is attending school next week.

## Reminders for Children Attending School

Please can we remind parents that if children are attending school during this lockdown period that they do not come to school if they have any symptoms of COVID-19, anyone in your household or support bubble has COVID-19 symptoms, anyone in your household or support bubble is awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test, or if your child has come into contact with anyone with COVID-19 and have been asked to isolate by Test and Trace.
